


NATE TEACHING AT THE BRITISH MUSEUM

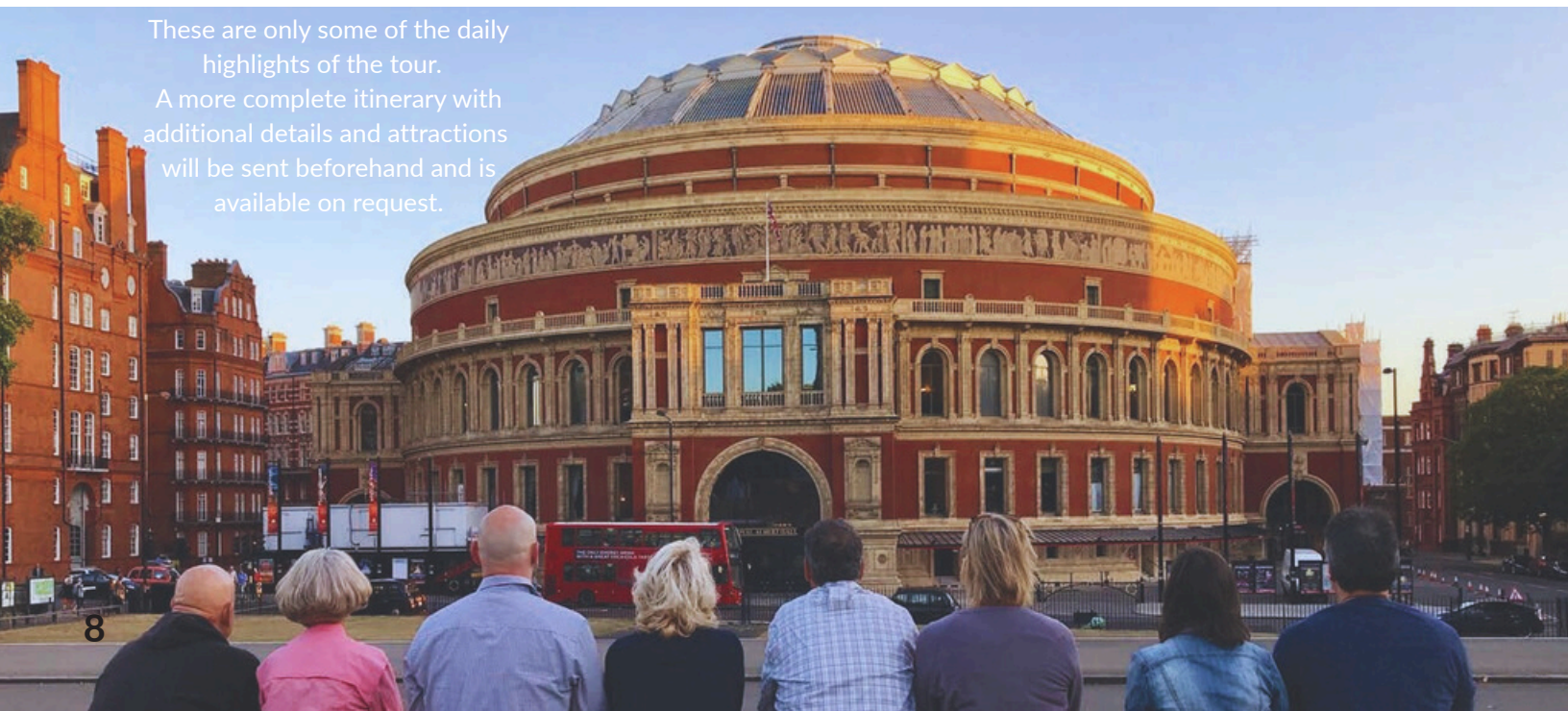

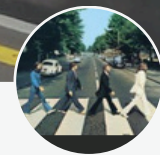

You can use the card to venture out for some fine dining, grab a show in the West End, or enjoy the London lights at night.

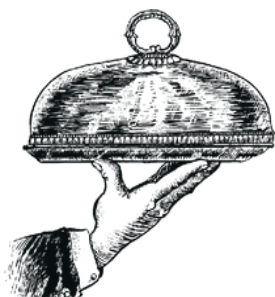

Keeping the group small allows us to access behind-the-scenes locations and enjoy unique experiences that larger groups simply can't.

It also makes travel more efficient and creates space for deeper connection—helping us learn, explore, and grow together like family over the course of the week.

THE PRICE IS \$2,195 PER PERSON AND INCLUDES:

- ✓ Hotel accommodations for 7 nights in our central London hotel.
- ✓ Entry fees to all attractions and tour locations we visit.
- ✓ Personal group tour guide the entire time, available 24/7.
- ✓ Unlimited public travel in and around Central London via Oyster card.
- ✓ Trip planning assistance before and after the tour.

Cost does not include your flight and initial travel to our London hotel before and after the tour, or most food expenses except breakfast, which we provide.

Each room has two twin beds in it and allows for a maximum of two guests per room. If you do not have any traveling companions for your room, we will try to organize someone of the same gender to share a room with you.

If you are attending the trip by yourself and you would like a private room it will be an additional \$150 per night.

PAYMENT METHODS

We accept personal checks, business checks, cashier's checks, and credit cards. You're welcome to pay your full balance upfront or wait till later. The remaining balance must be paid in full no later than 60 days before the tour begins.

TRIP INSURANCE

Due to unforeseen life changes, illness, or circumstances that prevent you from attending the tour, we do recommend purchasing trip insurance ahead of time.



WHY DO YOU NOT INCLUDE THE COST OF AIRFARE IN THE LONDON CHRISTIAN TOUR?

There are a few good reasons why we ask you to make your own travel arrangements to and from London...

First, guests often join us from across the U.S. and even internationally. Coordinating a single group flight would require everyone to first travel to a common departure city—often adding time, cost, and complexity.

Second, booking your own flights gives you more flexibility. You can choose your preferred airline, use frequent flyer miles, or select travel times that work best for you.

Lastly, some travelers like to extend their trip—arriving early to explore London or continuing on to other parts of Europe after the tour.

By handling your own airfare, you get the best options for your schedule and budget, while we focus on providing an incredible experience once you arrive in London.
